


## A KITCHEN IN CLAPHAM

The brief for this Clapham project was to extend and modernise the kitchen and whilst doing so, refurbish the double reception room of the Victorian terrace house. The homeowner had already extended the kitchen into the side return to create a kitchen, dining space and family area. They wanted it to be a calming space, but with a shot of colour and interest. The walls and units are neutral, allowing the blue island and gorgeous black and blue tiles stand out. The kitchen was supplied by Roundhouse. To add a sense of luxury to the dining space, the new wall was wallpapered and comfortable throws added. The client wanted the space to flow into the adjoining double reception room, which is linked with calming neutrals and splashes of colour. A new reading and music room was created at the rear with comfortable green velvet armchairs and bookshelves, whilst in the front area a glamorous chaise was re-upholstered and artwork added. A complimentary luxurious wallpaper links this space to the dining area.
