BESPOKE TOWNHOUSE

This Victorian town house has been refurbished by Emma Green Design. In the double reception room a neutral backdrop has been created in a calming warm grey and a mixture of both traditional and contemporary pieces have been added. Opulent blue velvet curtains, a tiered crystal chandelier, and the sculptural coffee table provide the glamorous elements the clients were seeking. The bespoke red and oak sideboard adds an injection of colour and an oversized lamp adds impact. In the guest bedroom, custom made built in wardrobes create maximum storage whilst seamlessly blending into the walls behind to give the illusion of space. The large-scale headboard covered in a Chinese inspired velvet toile is the focal point of the room. Bespoke cushions and soft furnishings compliment the scheme.
